

111 PEGASUS CADET UNIFORM POLICY

- 1) Cadets are to wear a white dress shirt, black dress pants, and black dress shoes (or similar appropriate dress) until they are issued a uniform.
- 2) Cadets will be issued a uniform free of charge within the first 3 months of joining the Squadron. If this not happen, cadets should contact the Supply Officer directly to inquire about the process.
- 3) Cadets will be issued the following items during their initial issue:
  - Wedge (1)
  - Tunic (1)
  - Short Sleeve Dress Shirt (1)
  - Tie (1)
  - Dress Pants (1 pr)
  - Dress Belt (1)
  - Wool Socks (1 pr)
  - Drill Boots (1 pr)
  - Crewneck Sweater (1)
  - Navy Blue T-Shirt (1)
  - Toque (1)
  - Parka (1, within 6 months of joining)
  - Black Gloves (1 pr, within 6 months of joining)
  - Nametag (1 free, within 6 months of joining)
  - Rank Slip-ons (1 pr)
  - Badges (as required)
- 4) The Squadron will endeavour to ensure all uniform items fit the cadet. If an item wears out due to reasonable wear and tear, or is outgrown, the cadet may exchange it at Supply anytime at no charge. However, cadets are responsible to maintain their uniforms in an appropriate condition. This is to include minor alterations if required (hemming, badge sewing), along with washing the uniform when required. Boots shall be kept polished and clean.
- 5) Information on uniform care and upkeep is available on the 111 Pegasus website under Cadet Information > Uniform Tips and Tricks.
- 6) Cadets are required to return their complete uniform, as issued to them above, within 1 week of leaving the squadron (including transfers to other units). Parents of cadets who fail to do so may be assessed a loss charge of \$500 to cover replacement of the uniform.
